### Missionary of the Week: Mohenus/Ghana

Seth was able to finish teaching the book of Romans for the first semester of Ghana Baptist Theological Institute. Please continue to pray that the Lord would provide for the following needs: solar panel project (\$2,000 still needed), bus for Faith Independent Baptist Church (\$25,000 still needed), and the completion of Winneba church building (\$5,673 still needed). Also, be in prayer for Fundamental Baptist Mission's deaf ministry. In August, the mission held their first deaf camp; 75 attended and 11 got saved.
