Bruce Tuttle- Ukraine/Georgia-I recently revealed two new exciting projects for the ministry in Ukraine. All of the estimated funding needed has been raised. In addition, sufficiently more has been received as a cushion! We will escrow the extra funds for a future project that appears to be developing in the future. I cannot thank you enough, both from my own heart and on behalf of the believers in Ukraine! Igor's church, in Ukraine, has raised over \$4,000 (and still counting). And that is from a country where they are financially stressed. In the Kharkiv region -- in an area that was taken and occupied by the Russian army, liberated by the Ukrainians, and devastated by Russian missiles and bombs ever since -- one Baptist church we have repeatedly helped has raised \$400 in their desire to reciprocate and help Pastor Igor's church. Also, they are contacting other Baptist churches in the same area, informing them, and asking whether they might also help. How preciously similar to the churches of Macedonia.
