**Bruce Tuttle – Georgia –** Micah, my oldest son, has continued providing a variety of theological books to the translators. Books that will be helpful for those whom we will be preparing for ministry are quite scarce in the Georgian language. I’ve been spending a few weeks teaching the remaining students in Ukraine the last courses of our institute there. Of course, this was via Zoom, online. I had hope to return to Ukraine to conduct a graduation for 7 men but discovered that such a trip would need to wait a month or so. I had asked you to pray for my dear friends, Andrey and Luda, and their son, Kyiv, for the removal of a tumor. The last I heard from Luda is that he is recovering well, but I haven’t heard whether or not there is still cancer present. I pray for this family as well as so many others I left behind in Ukraine.
