**David & Emily Stephens – North Africa:** David writes, Thank you for your continued prayers. I was able to make a short trip to a small town on the very edge of the Sahara desert to visit with some workers living there who are attempting to successfully share Christ, but finding receptive soil is nearly impossible. The nearest (native) Christian has since moved away leaving an absolute dearth of Gospel presence. Many towns literally on the edge of the world are on the very borders of the gospel's reach – "the uttermost part of the earth". It remains our desire to one day leave our current city and make our way to such a place, to stake a claim where Christ has not yet been named. We pray God gives us the wisdom and strength to both find and do His will. We recently received good news: Ivy's ocularist said she seems ready now to get a prosthetic eye! This was very exciting for Ivy who has been dealing with a rather obvious abnormality. This means that we need to plan a small trip back to the US in Dec. Pray for God to give wisdom as well as His provision for the trip and actual prosthetic itself (about \$4500). Continue to pray for our church here, that God would heal wounds and develop strong bonds of love.
