Bruce Tuttle—Eastern Europe- The situation here is rapidly deteriorating, and we need your prayers. My son and his family have been ministering in this mission field for the last 11+ years. Since the demonstrations, there has been unrest. Whereas the people's protests have been generally peaceful, the response of the ruling party has not. Opposition party leaders have been dragged from their homes and beaten. The government even hunted down protesters that could be identified and jailed them. On Monday, Dec. 16, I flew to Philadelphia to meet with a handful of pastors reasonably close to where I'd be lodging. Later this week, I will depart the U.S., return to my mission field, and then turn around to fly to the Bessarabia region. Two pastors will meet me there for further travel. I will spend about 10 days there, visiting some of our graduates and a couple of churches.
